Prioritizing my own health and well-being with a workout and a bit of "me time" before work begins.

11:00 AM - First Client: Lip Blush or Ombre Brows (£300)

Welcome my first client of the day for a bespoke PMU treatment—helping them wake up with makeup and feel their best.

1:00 PM - Second Client: Lip Blush or Ombre Brows (£300)

Another rewarding session, creating natural, confidence-boosting results for a client of any age, from 18 to 80+.

3:15 PM - School Run & Family Time, Dinner

Pause work to pick up my child, enjoy family time, and have dinner together—something that's hard to achieve in a typical 9-5 job.

6:00 PM - Touch-Up Appointment (£75-£150)

A quick evening appointment for a client's lip blush or brow touch-up—flexible and low-stress.

7:30 PM - Check Emails & Post on Social Media

Wrap up the day by responding to clients and sharing before-and-after photos on Instagram and Facebook to attract new bookings.

All while fitting in the school run, the gym, and dinner with family—proving that a PMU career can offer both financial rewards and real-life balance.

Step 1: Research PMU Training Options


Start by looking for accredited "permanent makeup academies" or "PMU training for beginners." Quality education is the foundation of your success.

Important: There's a difference between "accredited" and "Ofqual regulated" training. Make sure you choose a course that allows you to obtain insurance and your local licence—this is essential for working legally and safely as a PMU artist.


#### **Step 2: Book Your Training**

When choosing your provider, focus on hands-on training in small groups. You don't want your first model to be done while your instructor is trying to watch eight students at once—trust me, I've been there! I had to pay to retrain because I left my first course with no confidence.

Look for academies that offer ongoing support after training. The PMU industry is always evolving, so it's crucial to have someone guiding you through your journey—not just for the course, but beyond.

#### Step 3: Invest in the Right Tools

Many reputable courses will provide you with a starter kit—always check before booking so you know what's included. Having professional, quality tools is key to delivering great results and building your reputation as a PMU artist.

#### Step 4: Build Your Portfolio and Brand

You'll often need to complete case studies before receiving your certificate—use these as an opportunity to build your portfolio. Start sharing before-and-after photos and client stories on Instagram and Facebook to showcase your skills and attract new clients. Don't forget: once you're qualified, obtain your insurance and licence so you can operate legally and with peace of mind.

#### Step 5: Find Your First Clients

Offer introductory rates or promotions to friends, family, and local groups to get your first bookings. Always ask for testimonials—social proof builds trust and helps you attract more clients.

Answer: Yes! Typical daily earnings for a PMU artist can be £600-£750, with the flexibility to fit work around your life and family.



# FUN STEP: HOW MANY CLIENTS DO YOU NEED TO REPLACE YOUR MONTHLY INCOME?

Let's break it down:

- The average PMU treatment (like lip blush or ombre brows) is £300
- To match a typical full-time monthly salary in the UK (around £2,400), you'd only need to see 8 clients a month—that's just 2 clients per week!

One of my students recently worked out she only needed to see 2 clients per week to replace her full-time income. That's just around 5 hours of work per week—compared to her old 37.5-hour job!

#### Try it yourself:

- Write down your current monthly income.
- Divide by the average price of a PMU treatment (e.g., £300).
